Veteran Sweepstakes

Veteran Dogs 7-9 years

- 1) #46 Lubberline Martingale: Excellent front and rear angulations with a nice topline, excellent moving boy, a pleasure to see.
- 2) #54 Ch. Pirate's Spaghetti Western: Nice tail set, appeared to be heavier set and lighter in bone than 1st place.

Veteran Dogs 10+ years

- 1) #44 Ch. Riverroad Tiburon: Nice boy with a good topline, good angulation, moved well for his age. Always a pleasure to watch the oldies strut their stuff.

Veteran Bitch 7-9 years

- 1) #71 Tabatha's Confetti: Nice level topline, tail correctly off the back excellent front angulation and ear set.
- 2) #100 Castilleja's Jiffy Pop: Nice moving bitch with good angulation, slighter in bone than 1st place bitch.
- 3) #20 Ch Pirates's Small Change: A softer topline than the girls ahead of her and lighter in bone, nice tail set and good head with nice expression.
- 4) #9 Ch. OTCH. Castlegar Marlo At Autumwynd: Slight in bone for her structure, ears low set as well as the tail set.

Junior Puppy Dog

- 1) #89 Kilmaurs Autumn Thunder: Very nice puppy for his age, good front and rear angulation, nice earset and stop.
- 2) #70 Madabout's Time For A Change: Slightly high ear set, not as clean moving as 1st place boy, good topline, good front shoulder but lacking in rear angulation.
- 3) #28 Skazka Hugo Boss: Nice topline and tail set, slighter in bone then the first two boys, not as well angulated as first place.
- 4) #41 Kilmaurs Autumn Highlands: Very large male for his age, but good angulation, low ear set, level topline.

Senior Puppy Dog

- 1) #143 Tyric's New Kid In Town: Nicely angulated front and rear, nice head and tail set, lacking in coat.

- 2) #14 Pinebank Just You Wait Mr.: Slightly high in the rear, not as angulated as #1, good tail set and stop.
- 3) #119 Stonewood's E Costello Rocks: Straight in the front shoulders, good rear angulation, and tail carried gay while moving, level topline.

Open Dog

- 1) #101 Castilleja's Stewie O'Muskoka: Very nicely put together boy, well angulated with a level topline, excellent otter tail well set, nice reach of neck and clean moving. Easily caught my eye from the moment I saw him.
- 2) #73 Wayfield's Here Comes Charlie: Nice boy with a good topline, and tail set, good ear set and angulation.
- 3) #142 Nyroca'a Witch Doctor: Larger male than 1st and 2nd place, not as angulated, tail carried gay.

Junior Puppy Bitch

- 1) #121 East Hill Little Miss Marker: Nice front and rear angulation, good tail set with beautiful head and expression.
- 2) #158 Shanbro's Rah Rah Rah: Not as well angulated as #1, good topline and good bone for her body structure.
- 3) #27 Skazka Victoria's Secret Emma: Good topline, tail set not as good as 1 or 2, good stop and muzzle.
- 4) #16 Oaksill Crimson N Clover: Well put together girl, with good angulation in front but lacking in rear compared to the others, slight in bone for body structure.

Senior Puppy Bitch

- 1) #11 Evenstar's Sugar's Ms Daisy: Good front shoulder and rear with a good tail set, nice reach of neck.
- 2) #76 Granddrivers In Da Nick Of Time: Well boned for structure, good head, was a bit shy today but well put together.
- 3) #26 Santosha's Zenda Of Pinebank: A larger bitch than 1 or 2, and not as well angulated in the front, good tail set and reach of neck.
- 4) #34 Markwell's Poppy Red: Nice front and rear angulation, a little finer in bone than I like, clean moving bitch.

Open Bitch

- 1) #108 Piccadilly's Hidden Covey: Excellent front and rear angulation, would like to see a tighter foot, a very pleasing head with a good stop and ear set, clean moving, very nice overall.
- 2) #114 Ch Castlegar Bluebell: Good front and rear angulation, with a well set tail, ear set slightly low, not as much stop as bitch 1.
- 3) #117 Beadog Wicked Violet: Good expression and clean moving, not as well angulated in the front as 1 and 2, nice topline and tail set.
- 4) #102 Castlegar's Smooth Kahlua: Not as heavy as other but well boned for her structure, not as good of a tail set as the others.
